## A Peek At Our Week

- Our sight word for the week was "big". We also practiced the words "little" & "give". We see the words "little" & "give" in our reading series and many of our guided reading books. Keep practicing at home!
- We practiced deleting the initial and final sound in words (say the word "fit" without the /f/ and say the word "yes" without the /s/).
- We built the -ut family (but, cut, hut, etc.).
- Our shared reading activities focused on identifying the details in a story.
- We are reviewing writing numbers on lined paper in handwriting. This week we focused on the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, & 6.
- In writer's workshop we have been learning about sentence fluency. We learned that writing fluently means writing sentences of different lengths. This gives the piece an easy to listen to sound from beginning to end. We also learned that writers use different words to start each sentence. This makes the writing sound interesting, not robotic, and gives it a pleasing rhythm.
- We continued Topic 13 "Money" in math. This week we focused on the dime and quarter. Keep practicing identifying the penny, nickel, dime & quarter and the value of each coin with your child at home. The more your child practices, the more confident he/she will be!
- We have been working on Unit 5 "National Symbols" in Social Studies. We learned about many of our nation's symbols including the eagle, the American flag and the Statue of Liberty. We also discussed how we celebrate our country.
