A Peek at Our Week

- Our sight words for the week were "if", "is" & "it". Keep practicing at home!
- We reviewed the letters Yy & Zz (identify & letter sound)
- We reviewed our short /e/ word families (-ed, -en, -et, & -eg).
- We continued to practice segmenting the sounds we hear in spoken words.
- Our shared reading book this week was "I Went Walking" by Sue Williams. We made predictions about the story and sequenced the events of the story.
- We reviewed writing the letters Yy & Zz on lined paper for handwriting.
- We have been working hard on our class book that will be sent in for "publishing". We completed our rough drafts and began writing our stories on the final paper. We are so excited to see the final product!
- We began Topic 12 "Larger Numbers" in math. This week we reviewed the teen numbers, learned about odd and even numbers, looked at number patterns on a hundred chart and reviewed writing numbers to 100.
- We began Unit 7 "Weather and Seasons" in science. We discussed different types of weather, some of the tools used to measure weather (thermometer & windsock) and the seasons. We will continue with weather and seasons next week.
