- Our sight word for the week was "good". Keep practicing at home!
- We built the -eg word family (beg, leg, peg).
- We continued to practice segmenting the sounds we hear in spoken words.
- We practiced putting words in ABC order.
- During shared reading we identified text patterns and the main idea of a story.
- We reviewed writing the letters Vv, Ww & Xx on lined paper for handwriting.
- We have been working hard on our class book that will be sent in for "publishing". We have finished our story webs and we are beginning to work on our rough drafts.
- We used manipulatives to act out subtraction stories using the minus and equals sign. We made munching puppets and used our puppets to munch away cubes when acting out subtraction problems. We also got to go bowling for one of our subtraction activities! We had a lot of fun and practiced subtraction at the same time (10 pins - 3 pins = 7 pins)
- We read several Dr. Seuss books this week. Some of our Dr. Seuss activities included making the "Cat in the Hat" out of construction paper and painting hot air balloons and writing about a special place we would like to visit. We hung our cats and balloons in our classroom. On Friday we had green eggs and ham! YUM!
